

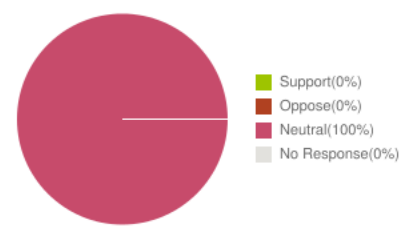

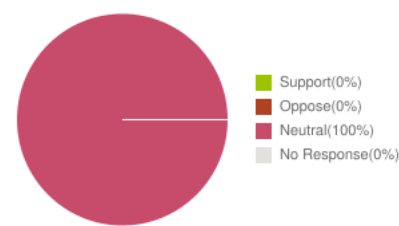
The following graphs display sentiments for comments that have location data. Only locations of users who have commented will be shown.

But I would like to consider the possibility of an initial implementation where City Council retains contract approval

authority for Level 2 projects between \$60k and \$200k. After an initial trial period, perhaps the transfer of Level 2 approval authority to City Manager could be then complete. Hopefully in this initial arrangement there would still be appreciable streamlining despite the Council Staff report for Level 2 approval.
