A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA APPROVING THE 2023–2024 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1974, the President of the United States signed into law the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Act); and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of Title I of the Act are the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hermosa Beach contracts with the Los Angeles County Development Authority for the disbursement of Community Development Block Grant Funds through the Small Cities Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hermosa Beach received \$71,519 in 2023–2024 Community Development Block Grant Funds and will carry forward unallocated CDBG Funds from prior years in an amount of \$75,629 for a total amount of \$147,148 to construct Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant curbs ramps that remove architectural and material barriers for senior and disabled persons; and

WHEREAS, the City Council conducted a public hearing, with the required prior noticing, to provide the public an opportunity to comment on the proposed program in accordance with the program requirements for the 2023–2024 Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for the proposed construction of ADA compliant sidewalks and curb ramps and instructs staff to submit the necessary

CDBG documents and a copy of this resolution to the Los Angeles County Development Authority.

SECTION 2. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or designee to execute all necessary contracts and agreements with the Los Angeles County Development Authority, in order complete the proposed CDBG Program changes which may be reviewed as necessary by the City Attorney.

SECTION 3. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager or designee to adjust the 2023–2024 CDBG Program and budget, as necessary, to consider any changes in the CDBG allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, any amounts remaining unspent at the close of the preceding fiscal year, and programmatic changes necessary to fulfill the requirements of the CDBG Program.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution and thenceforth and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
