A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA TO NOMINATE THE BIJOU BUILDING AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK

The City Council of the City of Hermosa Beach does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. On April 27th 1999, the City Council conducted a public meeting to consider whether to nominate the Bijou Building as a Historic Landmark, pursuant the provision of the City's Historic Preservation Ordinance, and to consider the Secretary of the Interior Standards for Rehabilitation of historic buildings in connection with the City's Historic Preservation Ordinance.

SECTION 2. Based on the evidence received at the public meeting of the City Council determined that the Bijou building meets the minimum eligibility requirements to be designated a landmark, and contains both interior and exterior architectural features with sufficient historic characteristics to justify its nomination as a landmark, pursuant to the Historic Preservation Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Based on the foregoing, the City Council hereby nominates the Bijou Building, located at 1229 Hermosa Avenue to be a Historic Landmark pursuant to Section 17.53.070 of the Historic Building Ordinance.
