Can someone please address the needs of some residents who only need a guest pass on occasion

when a visitor or service provider comes to the home? Often times it is impromptu and the date is not known

in advance. Maybe consider selling a limited number of SINGLE USE DAY PASSES per year for residents? They

could have barcodes on them and expire when the annual passes expire. The proposed \$150 guest pass (if I understand

it correctly) is exorbitant based on my needs, and I oppose changing the cost.

Also, I would appreciate it if Council Members would remember that we are a diverse community here in Hermosa

with residents who are incredibly wealthy, and others who live on low fixed incomes. If the Council decides to raise rates

for the guest pass can they consider a rebate for qualifying senior residents ? (with guidelines similar to the PropertyTax Rebate

program)
