I sent via e-mail to your attention some current pictures of the damage that a slow leak of a 12-inch sewer line did to our outdoor area adjacent to Herondo Street. If this is the impact of one little broken pipe, which included the necessity to remove two large trees, let me ask you: What happens when you send two million gallons of water within 15 feet of our homes every time it rains and what happens when there is a malfunction of the equipment?
