eComment: Dear city council, A few weeks ago, we all were presented with a lot of information regarding the Water Infiltration Project. No one disputes the need for the project. No one wants to prevent Hermosa Beach or the other participants in the watershed management district from cleaning up our beaches or the ocean. However, the Greenbelt is still the wrong location for this project. Even Tetra Tech, who admits never having designed a project this close to homes, admits they will need a variance because the soil and water levels are not sufficient for this project in this location. For my safety, that of my neighbors and our homes, I strongly urge you to select another location. Nothing presented in that study session proved the Greenbelt was a suitable location. In fact, it presented other options. Let's seriously explore those other options. For my safety and that of my neighbors, let's find a suitable and appropriate location for this project. I'm counting on you to do what is right even if it may not be the easiest.
