Business is certified, added to registry, and recognized





Savings Achieved Through Manhattan Beach's

Green Business Program

As an example, savings from 2013-2017:

GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS SAVED

Green businesses have saved 2,461,209 lbs of CO2 with a total savings of \$4,184 . That's the equivalent of:

Planting 3,825 Acres of Urban Trees

ENERGY SAVED

Green businesses have saved 210,863 kWh with a total savings of \$21,365. That's the equivalent of:

Powering **19** houses for an entire year



SOLID WASTE DIVERTED

Green businesses have saved **3,638,946** lbs of waste with a total savings of **\$244,355**.

WATER SAVED
