Item: 6a) REPORT 18-0616 CONSIDERATION OF ALTERNATIVE LOCATIONS FOR THE GREENBELT INFILTRATION PROJECT (Environmental Analyst Kristy Morris)

eComment: As you mentioned on the report for tonight's agenda related to the Proposed Infiltration Project, Hermosa Beach accounts for only 13.6% of the Design and Construction Cost among the cities of Redondo Beach, Torrance and Manhattan Beach. Also, Hermosa Beach accounts for only 5% of the Total EWMP (Enhanced Watershed Management Program) area per the March 2018 report (table ES-1). As a result, we propose to build a portion of the Stormwater Infiltration Project on the Beach Infiltration Trench at the end of the Herondo drain, and the rest of the project to be built in Redondo Beach. Redondo Beach accounts for 50.8% of the overall design and construction project, and its Total EWMP area is 25%. Therefore, the equitable solution would be for Redondo Beach to assume its fair share of the responsibility for the proper handling of their stormwater. All the cities want this project to be executed. Therefore, we believe this is one of the best solutions.

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Design and Construction Costs for the Proposed Stormwater Infiltration Project (Report 18-0616, October 9, 2018)

The total project budget is \$7,336,180

The cost sharing formula is based on each jurisdiction's contributing Tributary area to the project after subtracting the treatment capacity of the City of Torrance Basin Enhancement Project.

The City of Hermosa Beach's share for design costs is \$115,550.50 (13.6%)

The current estimate for the City of Hermosa Beach share of construction costs is \$460,651.59

Total project budget of \$576,202.09.

Redondo Beach design and construction costs 50.8%

Torrance design and construction costs 33.1%

Manhattan Beach design and construction costs 2.5%
