

- \$300 million annual revenue

# **EXEMPTIONS & CREDITS**

### **Exempted Parcels Include:**

- Government-owned
- Non-profit-owned
- Antelope Valley
- Low-income senior-owned (with application)



### Credits of up to 100%

- Available to all parcel owners
- Up to 80% credit for onsite stormwater improvements
- Up to 100% credit for additional activities

# **BALLOT QUESTION**

Los Angeles Region's Public Health and Safe, Clean Water Program

Shall an ordinance improving/protecting water quality; capturing rain/stormwater to increase safe drinking water supplies and prepare for future drought; protecting public health and marine life by reducing pollution, trash, toxins/plastics entering Los Angeles County waterways/bays/beaches; establishing a parcel tax of 2.5¢ per square foot impermeable area, exempting low-income seniors, of raising approximately \$300,000,000 annually until ended by voters, requiring independent audits, oversight and local control be adopted?
