

Alondra Park Multi-Benefit Stormwater Capture Project

Project Scope

The Project will divert urban and stormwater runoff into underground storage with options to 1) treat and reuse onsite for irrigation, 2) treat and release, or 3) release for sanitary sewer treatment. The project will also include above ground landscaping, low-impact-development features, and educational signage.

Project Benefits

The Project will improve the quality of our rivers and ocean, increase local water supply, and provide educational and outreach opportunities.

- Total Project Cost (preliminary): \$37M to \$56M
- Volume Captured (preliminary): 34 56 Acre-Feet
- Potential Partners: El Segundo, Hawthorne, Lawndale, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach

- Complete Project Concept Report Spring 2019
- Complete Design Plans Late 2020
- Begin Construction Mid 2021
- Complete Construction Early 2022
