Item: 6b) REPORT 19-0315 PARTICIPATION IN BEACH CITIES TRANSIT (BCT) LINE 109 AGREEMENT, WITH NO REQUIRED FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION FROM THE CITY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020, WITH THE CITIES OF EL SEGUNDO, MANHATTAN BEACH AND REDONDO BEACH, FUNDED FROM PROPOSITION A FUNDS (Community Development Director Ken Robertson)

eComment: I started my inquiry into BCT 109 line enablement of RTI (Real Time Information) on 4/16. In the TRANSIT SERVICE OPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF REDONDO BEACH AND THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH (effective 7/1/17) Hermosa Beach's portion of funding for RTI was discussed. As of 8/18, BCT had not yet even sent out the RFP for this technology. Due to the infrequent stops, it is critical to at least provide RTI for it's riders. In my last two discussions with BCT on this topic, they had zero urgency of honoring their commitment to this technology. Can you please ask BCT to get moving on this? It's been years. Thank you.
