2 3	A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD TUESDAY, MAY 11, 2021, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW
4	WHEREAS, a Special Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Hermosa
5	Beach, California, on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, as required by law; and
6	WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by
7	law; voting precincts were properly established; election officers were appointed; and in all
8	respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and
9	the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the
10	Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and
	WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 21-7267 adopted January 12, 2021, the County
11	Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to the City
12	Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."
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14 15	NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:
16	SECTION 1. That there was one (1) voting precinct established for the purpose of
17	holding said election.
18	That the whole number of ballots cast in the precinct (except vote-by-mail and provisional
19	voter ballots) was 3, and the whole number of vote-by-mail cast in the City was 4,476, making a
20	total of 4,479 ballots cast in the City.
21	<b>SECTION 2.</b> That the names of the persons voted for at the election for Member of the
	City Council were as follows:
22	Randy BalikRaymond JacksonDean Francois
23	Tara McNamara Stabile Daniel Rittenhouse
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1	<b>SECTION 3.</b> That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes
1	given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective office for which the
2	persons were candidates were as listed in the Exhibit "A" attached.
3	SECTION 4. That the City Council does declare and determine that:
4	- Raymond Jackson was elected as Member of the City Council to fill the vacancy
5	created by the resignation of Hany Fangary for the remainder of that term, through
6	November, 2022.;
7	<b>SECTION 5.</b> That the City Clerk shall enter in the records of the City Council of the
	City of Hermosa Beach a statement of the result of the election, showing: (a) the whole number
8	of ballots cast in the City; (b) the names of the persons voted for; (c) what office each person was
9	voted for; (d) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person.
10	<b>SECTION 6.</b> That the City Clerk shall immediately make and present to the person so
11	elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk
12	shall also administer to the person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the
	State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk.
13	The person so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which he has been
14	elected.
15	SECTION 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
16	resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
