ORDINANCE NO. 20-1418 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HERMOSA BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING TITLE 10 (VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC) OF THE HERMOSA BEACH MUNICIPAL CODE TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY PROHIBITION ON SHARED MOBILITY DEVICES FROM BEING OFFERED FOR USE ANYWHERE IN THE CITY; PLACED IN ANY PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY OR PUBLIC PROPERTY; OR OPERATED ON ANY PUBLIC PROPERTY OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY
